



**A Phase 3 clinical research study of a Cystic Fibrosis therapy—
Denufosal Tetrasodium Inhalation Solution**

Right now, doctors who specialize in the treatment of Cystic Fibrosis (CF) are actively seeking patients for a research study of an investigational medication called denufosal (denufosal tetrasodium inhalation solution). The purpose of this study is to evaluate the safety and effectiveness of denufosal versus placebo by measuring changes in lung function. CF doctors conducting the study will determine your eligibility. You (or your child) may qualify for the study if you meet the following criteria:

- Have a confirmed diagnosis of cystic fibrosis
- Are at least 5 years old
- Are able to perform lung function tests consistently
- Have lung function (FEV1) of between 75% and 110% of predicted
